### **Healing Beyond Borders HTI Healing Touch Certificate Program Courses 4 & 5**

If you have completed courses 1-3 of the Healing Beyond Borders HTI HT Certificate Program and would like to continue your development as a healer, consider completing the program by attending *Case Management and Professional Practice* and *Self-Evaluation and Professional Development*. The experiences you have may intrigue you, both at the class and as you complete the course 4 homework assignments at your own pace. Whether or not you are planning on completing course 5 the emphasis is on developing yourself as an energy practitioner. After attending course 4 you become a Healing Touch International Practitioner Apprentice (HTI-PA). Course 5 is another level of refinement and a time of celebration. Attending course 5 and successfully completing the course 4 homework brings a sense of completion and the title of Healing Touch International Practitioner (HTI-P). HTI-P may apply to Healing Beyond Borders for certification.

These classes are usually held in retreat settings to allow for greater focus on the intense learning and practice that occurs and participants are expected to stay on-site. It is important to register early by sending your deposit so that the necessary arrangements can be made. (HT Canada may deem it necessary to re-schedule a class if sufficient registrations have not been received at least 16 or more weeks prior.) A \$50 early registration discount is applicable for registrations received prior to the dates indicated in the schedules below.

***Case Management and Professional Practice***, is the fourth course of study for the Healing Beyond Borders HTI Healing Touch Certificate Program that offers 25.5 continuing education contact hours of instruction. This course is for students who have completed the previous 3 courses, *Foundations of Healing Touch, Energetic Patterning and Clinical Application* and *Advanced Healer Preparation*.

#### **Course Description:**

To align with the responsibilities of professional practice, this course is a practicum in which case management is implemented and multiple Healing Touch sessions are delivered over a period of time.

#### **Course 4 Objectives**

The learner will be able to:

1. Apply a meditation (Ethereic Vitality) to clear and raise the personal energetic vibration.
2. Create sequential Healing Touch sessions appropriate to a patient's presentation.
3. Explore a variety of methods for practicing Healing Touch.
4. Work with other health care providers in a professional manner.
5. Describe the practicum process.
6. Identify how the Healing Beyond Borders Code of Ethics, Standards of Practice and Scope of Practice required of an advanced Healing Touch practitioner correlates to issues in their practice.

#### **Course 4 Content**

- Professional practice issues
- Professional legal and ethical issues
- Case management using the framework for a Healing Touch session
- Case study presentation to professional peers
- In-depth study of clinical applications
- Advanced healer preparation: Etheric Vitality Meditation
- Preparation for mentorship and practicum
- Advanced healer development

***Self-Evaluation and Professional Development***, is the fifth course of study for the Healing Beyond Borders HTI Healing Touch Certificate Program that offers 24 continuing education contact hours of instruction. This course is for students who have completed the previous 4 courses, *Foundations of Healing Touch, Energetic Patterning and Clinical Application, Advanced Healer Preparation and Case Management and Professional Practice*.

**Course Description:**

Completed mentorship activities are reviewed and evaluated to assist the students in identifying activities that can help them to grow in their professional practitioner role.

**Course Five Objectives**

The learner will be able to:

1. Analyze personal strengths, challenges and growth opportunities related to the practitioner role.
2. Evolve in the role from Healing Touch Student to Practitioner.
3. Share specific practicum learning to enhance personal and professional growth.
4. Collaborate in the review of clinical case studies.
5. Correlate research studies to case situations and choices of treatment.
6. Present clinical cases to groups of professional care providers.
7. Incorporate into one’s professional practice the Healing Beyond Borders Code of Ethics, Standards of Practice and Scope of Practice required of a Healing Touch practitioner.

**Course Five Content**

- Case study presentation
- Clinical application refinement
- Presentation and evaluation of practicum experiences including healing modalities, reading program, mentorship and community service
- Identification of strengths and growth opportunities for the Healing Touch Practitioner
